WHAT IS DUAL CREDIT?

Dual credit is the term given to courses in which high school students have the opportunity to earn both high school and college credits while enrolled at Hobart High School. Courses are taught by the high school faculty.

An agreement must be made between secondary and post-secondary schools to establish dual credit partnerships. Currently, each post-secondary school has different requirements for acceptance, teacher requirements and curriculum.
