When to use our services:*

Emergency Room or 911

Emergency rooms treat patients with life-threatening conditions who need care immediately, such as when there is:

- Serious risk to the health of the individual, or to a pregnant woman or her unborn child
- Serious impairment to bodily functions.
- Serious dysfunction of any body organ or part.
- Serious or severe injuries
- Burns or electrical shock
- Chest pain or pressure
- Coughing or vomiting blood
- Difficulty breathing
- Head trauma or change in mental status
- Loss of consciousness or fainting
- Poison ingestion
- Seizure
- Sudden facial drooping or weakness in an arm or lea
- Sudden loss of vision or blurred vision
- Sudden severe pain
- Uncontrolled bleeding.
- Vaginal bleeding during pregnancy
