#### WHAT:

All 5<sup>th</sup> grade students are invited to join choir! Auditions are not required. Turn in the signed and completed application to Mrs. Amsler. The **deadline for applications this year is September 9<sup>th</sup>**.

Choir will meet **Tuesdays during lunch recess** beginning **September 13<sup>th</sup>**. We will be studying all types of music with several performances throughout the school year.

#### STUDENTS MUST:

- Attend most of the rehearsals in order to learn the music well enough to sing for the concert,. A student is permitted to miss 3 rehearsals for any reason. No excuses are necessary. On the 4th absence, the student will no longer be an active member of the choir.
- Follow all school rules during rehearsals and performances. A student who receives more than 2 warnings during a rehearsal will no longer be an active member of choir.

## **DRESS**

Students will need a pair of black pants (not jeans), a black belt and black closed toe shoes (no sandals) along with their choir shirt for each performance. Shirts order forms will go home in a few weeks.
