Reading Strategy

Make a Picture or Mental Image

When readers listen to or read text, they can create pictures in their mind or make a mind movie. This helps a reader to remember more of what they read or heard.

When reading at home:

~Explain that there are many ways pictures help readers remember what they are reading. They can do this by:

- Thinking about what they know about the text before they read.
 - Use sensory details to create mental pictures
 - Looking back at the picture in your brain after the story to remember what has happened.

Ask: "What do you see in your mind as I read?, Can you see yourself in this story?, or Explain to me the picture in your mind."
