When reading at home, remember to ask your child questions about what happened in the story. Talk about the beginning, middle, and end. You can do this when watching movies too!
- -Keep practicing the **sight words**! The students are learning about 6 new words a week! Try having your child use them in their writing too. Their words should match their picture.
- -Number sense and problem solving are important skills to develop at this age.
