

Instrument Care Agreement

HOBART STRING ORCHESTRA

Thank you for making orchestra a part of your school experience! We are very fortunate to have quality instruments for cello and bass students. These instruments stay at school and are only to be used during class or by permission of the director. We have no borrowing fee, because the high cost expected of your at-home cello and bass instruments. We do require students to demonstrate proper behaviors that will extend the life of the instruments.

CARE AGREEMENT:

1. Instruments stay at school and are only available to students at times prescribed by Mr. Grenier
2. Students who do not follow class procedures regarding instrument care, will face school disciplinary procedures. Our procedures promote proper care and prevent possible damage to the instruments.
3. Students that repeated do not follow care procedures or intentionally damage an instrument may be liable for the damage, school discipline, and possible removable from the orchestra.

CARE PROCEDURES:

1. Always keep two hands on the instrument at all times.
2. No one other than you can carry or play your instrument.
3. Only lay down the instrument when instructed by Mr. Grenier
4. Always walk around instruments and never over them.
5. Never leave an instrument against a chair or leaning against anything.
6. Be careful with bows. Lay them down carefully when not in use.
7. Never touch the bow hair!
8. When finished rehearsing, wipe off rosin dust from the instrument. Always loosen tension from bows when complete
